Hong Kong's February exports beat expectations

- Hong Kong's exports +24.7% in February, while imports +29.9%.
- Global demand for artificial intelligence (AI)-related electronic products supported Hong Kong's merchandise trade.
- Exports to most markets and across major commodity categories continued to see significant growth.

- Increases were registered in the values of total exports of most principal commodity divisions, in particular "electrical machinery, apparatus and appliances, and electrical parts thereof" (+30.8%), "telecommunications and sound recording and reproducing apparatus and equipment" (+41.5%) and "non-ferrous metals" (+289.4%).
